Bolivia has long been overlooked on the global wine map — and a new generation of high-altitude vineyards is quietly changing that, producing elegant, expressive wines shaped by intense sunlight, cool mountain air, and volcanic soils.

This journey is built for travelers who are curious, unhurried, and drawn to places just before the rest of the world catches on. A refined escape where wine, culture, and landscape come together slowly, intentionally, and without pretense. No rushing. No checklist. Just the real Samaipata, at the right pace.

DAY · WEDNESDAY

01 Arrival

Gentle Decompression

You land, and the city slips away behind you. The road climbs into the foothills, a light Bolivian breakfast waiting in the car. By late afternoon you're settling into your home for the week — no decisions to make, nothing to organize. The journey begins by simply arriving.

- **Private airport welcome**
Personally greeted at Viru Viru and escorted to your private vehicle for the scenic drive into the mountains.
- **Cuevas Coffee Roasters**
A single, pre-arranged pause for specialty coffee and a fresh pastry. From seed to cup — and a moment to reset.
- **Arrival at El Pueblito**
Bags handled, rooms ready, a welcome drink in hand before sunset.
- **Welcome dinner**
A simple, unhurried first dinner at the hotel. Tonight is about settling in.

DAY · THURSDAY

El Fuerte

Context & Ancient Stone

A leisurely start, then a private guide leads you through El Fuerte de Samaipata — a story-driven walk through one of the most enigmatic archaeological sites in the Andes. The day is about understanding where you are, without being asked to do too much.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- **El Fuerte de Samaipata**
Private guided visit to the UNESCO-listed site, unhurried and focused on meaning and place rather than dense detail.
- **El Fuerte Museum**
A concise, thoughtful complement to the ruins.
- **Picnic lunch at the site**
A curated picnic among the stones — the landscape as your dining room.
- **Dinner at Casa Charo**
One of Bolivia's finest tables. A multi-course tasting menu paired with wines from across the country's regions.

DAY · FRIDAY

03 Wine Without Hurry

Indulgence

An unstructured morning, then the day belongs to wine. A seated, guided tasting at Winery 1750 flows naturally into a long, leisurely lunch on site. There is no rush, and no pressure to move on. Today is about savoring — wine, conversation, and the luxury of time.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- **Winery 1750 (Uvairenda)**

A seated, guided tasting of high-altitude Bolivian wines — meeting the people who make them, not a tour desk.

- **Lunch at the winery**

A long lunch among the vines, paced to the rhythm of the afternoon.

- **Afternoon at leisure**

Reading, napping, the gardens, or simply doing nothing at all.

- **Dinner at Michelangelo**

A refined evening table, with an optional sunset wine to begin.

DAY · SATURDAY

04 Wine & Hummingbirds

Permission & Pleasure

A slow morning by design — space in the day so the afternoon feels like a highlight, not something squeezed in. Then wine, vineyard, and one of the region's quiet wonders: a garden alive with hummingbirds.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- **Landsúa Winery**

A guided tour of the vineyard and winery, followed by lunch on site.

- **Hummingbird Refuge**

Up to 25 species hover and feed in this rustic, beautiful garden — birdwatching at arm's length.

- **Dinner at Latina Samaipata**

An evening table in town to close a day built on restraint and reward.

DAY SUNDAY

05 Forest & Brewery

Sensory Focus

A walk through one of Samaipata's most extraordinary natural treasures — the Giant Ferns Forest, deep in the fringes of Amboró National Park. A landscape both surreal and prehistoric. Today is about engaging deeply with one part of the region, and letting it linger.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- **Giant Ferns Forest**

A guided walk among prehistoric tree ferns in the cloud-forest edge of Amboró National Park.

- **El Fuerte Brewery**

A curated lunch and tasting at a leading artisanal brewery, crafted by friends settled in Samaipata from faraway lands.

- **A flexible evening**

The night stays quiet and open — time to rest and reflect.

DAY · MONDAY

06 Soft Re-Entry

Closure

A slow morning, then the gentle drive back toward Santa Cruz — a final café stop along the way rather than an abrupt departure. The journey ends the way it began: smoothly, and without stress.

A slow breakfast before the scenic drive down from the mountains.
- **Lunch at the plaza**
Time on your own in the Samaipata plaza — wander, browse, linger.
- **Farewell cocktail reception**
A final gathering to raise a glass to the week and the conversations you'll carry home.
- **Concierge: shopping & spa**
In Santa Cruz, your personal concierge can arrange boutique shopping and spa services — bookable on request, tailored to you.
- **Santa Cruz & transfer**
An overnight near the airport, with a private transfer arranged to your flight.
